<u>Belts</u>

a) Must be black or brown without jewels or metal beading.

 b) If a garment has belt loops, students must wear a belt (excluding Kinder & 1st)
Belt loops cannot be cut off.

MACS T-Shirt/College Shirt

- a) EVERY THURSDAY MACS shirt or sweatshirt
- b) Once a Month College T-shirts may be worn with jeans

<u>Hats</u>

No caps, beanies, hats, or any other head coverings shall be worn in the building. Bandanas are not allowed on campus.

<u>Shoes</u>

a) Must be closed toed and closed heel back and appropriate for Recess and Physical Education Class. **No Sandals allowed.**

<u>Students are encouraged to wear</u> <u>Tennis/Athletic shoes daily.</u>

b) No shoes with wheels or lights are allowed.

c) Shoelaces must remain tied.

d) Boots are allowed but must be changed for PE.

e) High heeled footwear (more than 1 inch) is not allowed.

Socks/Tights

White, Black, Gray or Navy (Solid Color) **"One size rule" applies. (one size larger than**

actual measurement to allow for growth)

<u>Masks</u>

Masks are allowed and optional. Masks may not depict drugs, sex, violence, or alcohol. (Masks with skulls, inappropriate graphics or words are not to be worn.) See note***

Accessories & Jewelry

a) Girls may wear simple stud earrings (one per ear) that do not hang from the ear. Boys cannot wear earrings at any time. No other jewelry is allowed. No excessive jewelry.

b) No piercing other than in the ear is allowed.c) Wristwatches are allowed but must **not** have lights or sounds to distract others.

d) Tattoos and body glitter are not allowed.

e) Artificial/fake, dipped, or acrylic nails are not allowed at any time.

f) Make-up is not permitted in K-6th grades.

<u>Hair</u>

a) Must be kept neat and out of eyes.

b) No facial hair is allowed.

c) For boys, hair should not extend below the jawline or over the shirt collar.

d) No drastic hairstyles (mohawks, shaved letters/numbers, designs) or unnatural hair colors. Shaved heads are not allowed unless in the form of a complete burr.

e) Headbands should be flat across the head. Headbands that depict cat ears, unicorns, or any other distractors are not allowed. No sweatbands are allowed on the head or wrists.

Buyer Beware

Most local clothing stores also carry many brands and styles that are not allowed within the Standard Attire requirements.



Shirts

- White, Gray, Maroon, Black, or Navy (Must be a solid color)
 - a) Short or long-sleeve solid color polo, turtleneck or Oxford type with collar.
 - b) Must be buttoned to within 2 buttons from the top.
 - c) All shirts must be tucked in while at school.
 - d) No logos on shirts.



Undershirts

White, Gray, Maroon, Black, or Navy (Must be a solid color)

a) Short or long sleeved shirts and turtlenecks can be worn under the collared uniform shirt but must be white, gray, maroon, black, or navy.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts

Navy, Gray, Maroon, Black or White Cardigan sweaters, fleece jackets, sweatshirts are allowed to be worn at all times (Must be solid color)

a) Must be worn over a collared standard attire.

- b) Collar must be visible.
- c) Cannot have hoodie or drawstrings. (Must be banded at waist)
- d) One size rule enforced.

e) May be worn in the building as long as standard attire guidelines are met and they are not tied around the waist. Coats, jackets, and hooded items may be worn outside during PE/Recess but not worn in the hallways or classrooms. Hoodies are not allowed.



Pants/Shorts/Skirts/

Jumpers

Navy or Khaki

- a) Garments are to be fitted and not baggy. SAGGING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. One-size rule will be enforced
- b) No ripped, torn, or clothing with holes; garments must be hemmed.
- c) Skirts and shorts can only be 3 inches above the knee (includes the slit on skirts).
- d) Girls may wear leggings/tights under skirts (3 inch rule applies) but they must be solid gray, white, or navy.
- e) Leggings/Jeggings may not be worn alone.
